



* ** **File Formats****. Photoshop supports a range of image file formats, including JPEG, GIF, and TIFF files, as well as Photoshop format PSD files. For most people, the easiest way to get started is to use the JPEG format. Most photographers and the people who work with them use JPEG because it is the most commonly accepted file format, and so the JPEG files are the easiest to create and convert. To bring in a JPEG image, click File > Import > From Files, which opens the Import dialog box shown in Figure 1-14. Browse through the files on your computer and select the one you want to work with. You may need to change the Image Size setting to match the dimensions of the image you want to work with. Figure 1-14. The Import dialog box has six main options: Filters, Alignment, Masking, Layers, Borders, and Type. If you have a particular need, you can use the search field at the bottom of the box to locate any filter, alignment, or masking option that may work for you. When you have an image selected in the dialog box, you'll have some basic options. Use the filter controls to alter the appearance of the image as it's imported. Use the Alignment tool to change the position of the image on the canvas, and use the Type tools to apply any typographic features to the image.

Deletion of the AgMDH2 promoter in *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* confers high alcohol tolerance and increases the sugar utilization efficiency under aerobic conditions. AgMDH2 encodes a mitochondrial isoform of malate dehydrogenase (Mn-MDH) of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* that is induced in cells grown in medium containing 3-5% alcohol. In order to study the in vivo function of the AgMDH2 gene, we constructed and analysed a deletion strain (mh1-3) that has an approximately 800bp truncation and a duplication of the promoter region of AgMDH2. The mh1-3 cells exhibited a much higher tolerance to ethanol than that of the wild-type (wt) strain, and the wt cells became more susceptible to ethanol as the growth medium was depleted of nutrients. These results suggest that the AgMDH2 gene is involved in the regulation of alcohol tolerance. In addition, AgMDH2, which is upregulated by both alcohol and glucose, enhanced the ethanol production when the cells were cultured aerobically. Therefore, the deletion of the AgMDH2 gene can be a useful method for improvement of ethanol productivity.
